LIFE MEMBER DUES NEW FEE SCHEDULE

Consider becoming a Life Member – After One (1) year of membership, any member can become a Life Member of the Marine Corps League.

Effective 1 JULY 2023, the Life Membership Fees Increased as follows:

- \$1000.00 35 years of age and lower
- \$800.00 36-50 years of age
- \$600.00 51-64 years of age
- \$400.00 65-84 years of age
- \$100.00 85 years of age and higher

A member's annual dues must be paid up-to-date and the member is in good standing. Any member desiring to become a life member this year must postmark their payment before 1 September or it will apply to next year.
